

GGW Role: Co-Chair International Sub-Committee / GGW Lead in ANZ

Can you share a bit about your journey in the gaming industry and how you became involved with Global Gaming Women (GGW)?

I joined the industry almost 13 years ago now leading People & Culture for Aristocrat's creative studios. At the time that was a few hundred people primarily in Australia the US and India. Today I lead our People & Culture team across the Aristocrat group of companies where we have almost 8000 people soon to be 9000 plus in countries all around the world including those above and places like Spain, Israel, Ukraine and Canada just to name a few. I first attended a GGW event (kick up your heels) as part of G2E and was in awe at the amount of talented capable women in one room so I knew I wanted to be part of that. After starting up a similar organisation in Australia called Women in Gaming & Hospitality I was thrilled at the opportunity to be part of bringing the GGW to brand to life outside the US and creating moments that matter for the many talented women in our industry outside the

As a member of GGW, what role do you see yourself playing in promoting the organization's mission and encouraging more women to pursue careers in the gaming industry?

I feel very fortunate to work for Aristocrat where I have been given opportunity after opportunity to grow my career and develop new skills but I know that's not the reality for many women in our industry so i want to leverage the great work of those before me to really put GGW in the spotlight outside of the US and enable others to accelerate their careers in this incredibly diverse industry.

As a member of GGW, how do you envision your ongoing role in contributing to the organization's global expansion, and what goals do you have for fostering diversity and inclusion on an international scale?

This is what I am all about. I want to help put the G (global) in GGW.

The gaming industry can vary significantly from one country to another. How has GGW adapted its resources and programs to address the unique challenges and opportunities faced by women in gaming in different parts of the world?

I think this is a work in progress but the most exciting part is the commitment of everyone involved to achieve this. Offerings that work in one market wont always resonate in others so we need to work to get the balance right between local activities that are meaningful in home markets with global activities that can really expand our horizons and open us up to different ways of thinking. This is something I personally want to champion in my role on the GGW international Committee.

GGW emphasizes the importance of a global network. How have you personally benefited from connecting with women in the gaming industry from various parts of the world through GGW, and how has this impacted your professional growth?

Leading People & Culture for a global organisation with a significant US employee population many of the connections I have made through GGW have helped me better understand the nuances with US market and talent practices. Connections with people like Christie Eikelman, Lauren Bates and Kelly Hatch not just about GGW but about a broad variety of topics across our industry have been super helpful in enabling to me to navigate my way around the world. More recently I also had the pleasure of working closely with people like Grainne Hurst and Kimberley Broad and that is really helping build my European knowledge base with a outside Aristocrat perspective.



2023 EDUCATION HIGHLIGHTS

In 2023, GGW offered four separate programs built on an Education Pyramid of course curriculum, business skills and personal growth. Seven in person conference were held in Las Vegas, NV, Grantville, Pennsylvania and Tulsa, Oklahoma.

In total, 164 women attended these programs with scholarships!

Western Leadership Conference

The 2023 programming series began with a two-day Western Leadership Development Conference in Las Vegas at Suncoast, targeting supervisor-level women in the gaming industry. Focused on enhancing management skills, the conference emphasized communication, leadership styles, critical thinking, and workplace decision-making.





Western W Conference

In April 2023, Konami organized the Western W Conference in Las Vegas, part of the 2023 educational series. Limited to 24 senior-level women in gaming, hospitality, and supporting industries, the exclusive 3-day training program centered on leadership and personal growth for professional and personal improvement.

W Alumni Conference Recap

GGW held the W Alumni Conference in Las Vegas at Konami in June, featuring 19 women who have participated in the W Development Conference in the past. The 2-day alumni event focuses on how members can "pay it forward" and invest in GGW opportunities for existing and future members.





Las Vegas Leadership Foundations Recap

The Leadership Foundations Conference in Las Vegas at Konami in July celebrated outstanding gaming professionals, with 34 women participating in two full-day sessions focused on acquiring foundational skills for career advancement.
