

As we approach the end of 2023, I wanted to express my tremendous gratitude for the support of our sponsors, volunteers and members who have made this past year truly remarkable for GGW. It is important to reflect on the year's accomplishments and milestones that lay a foundation for even greater achievements to come, and to highlight the impact of your charitable dollars in this 2023 Annual Report. As we head into 2024, I am filled with anticipation and excitement for the future of GGW.

In 2023, our membership expanded to over 7,000 members spanning across 30 countries—a collective of industry professionals at all levels who received access to GGW programming and resources that allowed them to grow, both professionally and personally, within our shared gaming industry. Throughout the past year, GGW raised record-setting funds that allowed us to provide 7 live education conferences, host over 11 industry events, offer 11 Virtual Master Classes, fund over \$410,000 in scholarship opportunities, and provide the platform for over 300 women to participate in mentorship circles and other development opportunities. included key events with record-setting attendance, such as our 13th annual Kick Up Your Heels Event held during G2E, which raised over \$450,000 and included the unveiling of GGW's new brand symbolizing the maturity and expanded reach of our organization. These milestones occurred while our Board, Committee Members and Volunteers also worked in the background to continue refining critical organizational infrastructure, ensuring we are positioned for sustainable success in driving GGW's original mission established in 2011: support, inspire and influence the development of women in the gaming industry.

Throughout the last 12 years, the gaming industry has witnessed GGW evolve, flourish, and ultimately cement a culture of collaboration and a framework of support for the talented, unique women that make up our industry. My term as President closes at the end of 2023, and I am humbled and inspired by the engagement and support I have seen from the men and women I met and have worked with in this role. I couldn't be more excited for the future of GGW and look forward to continuing to support GGW as it executes its strategic initiatives and vision for 2024.

I thank you all for trusting me to lead your organization, and I hope you'll join me in continuing to support GGW and its mission. We know there are countless deserving causes competing for your charitable dollars, and we remain extremely grateful for your support of GGW and the lasting imprint your contributions leave on the women in our industry.
